The Hall of Fame program was created to recognize and honor men and women who have participated in the athletic events and programs of the Wisconsin Senior Olympics.

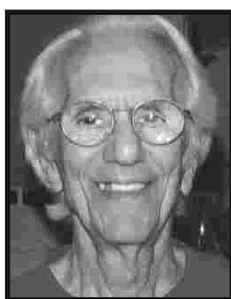
The Selection Committee will honor up to five seniors in 2008, who have excelled as athletes or volunteers, and who have made significant contributions to the success of the Senior Olympics.
